Solar Eclipse

The next solar eclipse in Tucson will be a partial eclipse on Monday, April 8, 2024, between 10:06 and 12:36. This event is an exciting opportunity for our students to experience the impact of the moon passing between the Sun and the Earth. With the FFO's support, we have secured solar eclipse glasses for each student to use during the eclipse with the approved ISO number recommended by NASA. Students should not wear regular sunglasses as they do not provide the needed eye protection. Over the next week, our students will be learning about the upcoming solar eclipse and safety procedures which include wearing the solar eclipse glasses when viewing the eclipse.

The time of the eclipse will take place during recess and lunch. Most of our lunch seating is in the shade and can accommodate students sitting in the shady areas. Students will wear the glasses to recess. Also, we will have Lego and games in the library for any student who would like to be indoors. If you would like your child to have recess in the library instead of the playground, please let your child's teacher know by Friday, April 5.

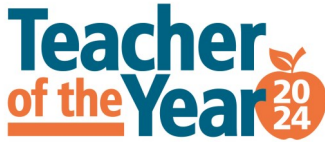
RE: Annual FFO Donation for the TOY Celebration
